4th of July Fireworks: Please follow the Fishers fireworks ordinance! See summary below. Fireworks are not allowed to be launched in Windermere Park (park closes at dusk). Your neighbors (particularly children and pets) may not be as enthusiastic about fireworks as you are. ***Please be considerate and respectful as you celebrate.***

Please remember, Ironwood Golf Club is private property, available only to their patrons.

No fireworks should be set or land on the golf course. No walking, running or riding on Ironwood paths. No e-bikes or e-motorcycles allowed. Ironwood greens have been damaged in past years by bicycles or mini-bikes. Ironwood advises they will address trespassing assertively. Property maintenance concerns, vandalism, or trespassing should be reported directly to Ironwood at 317-842-0551.

Street Tree Trimming – Protect Your Neighbors!

Trim trees and shrubs extending over sidewalks and streets. Shrubs must not spill over the sidewalk or street. Trees must be trimmed to assure **minimum clearance of seven feet over the sidewalk.**

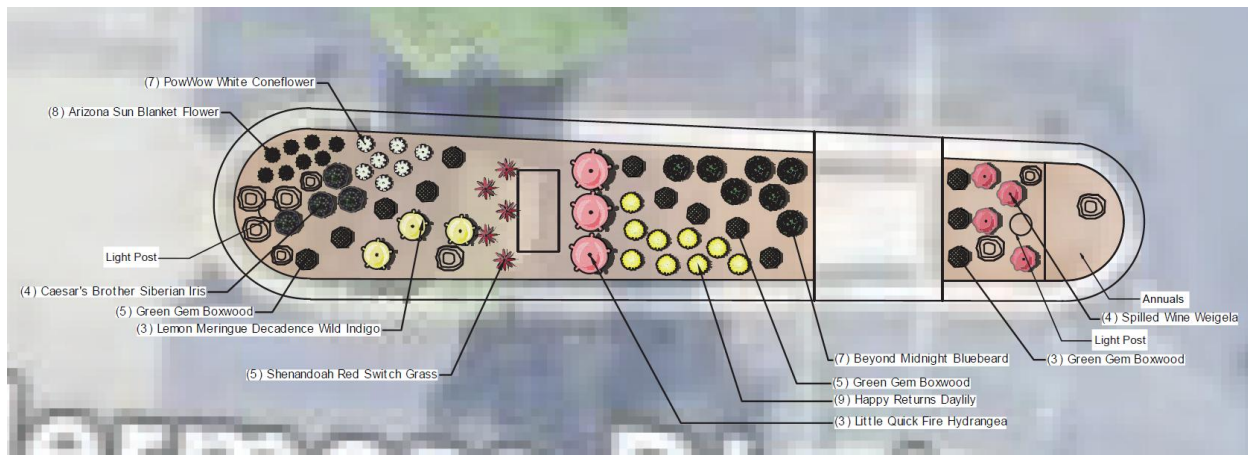
The City of Fishers requests ten-foot minimum branch clearance over streets at the curb and fourteen feet at roadway center to assure proper clearance for fire/emergency equipment and school buses, as well as snowplows in the winter. The City of Fishers reserves the right to trim right-of-way trees *as it sees fit* if property owners do not.

106th & Windermere Boulevard Island Renovation

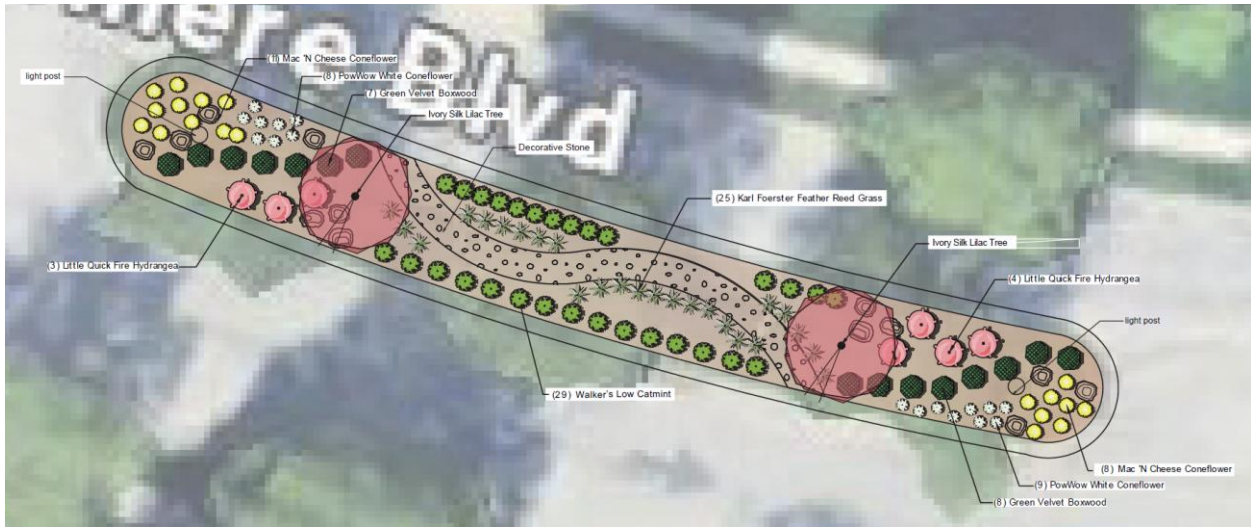
First steps have been taken on the full renovation of the 3 islands at the 106th & Windermere Boulevard entrance. We all love mature trees, but the invasive Bradford Pears at that location (like many in Windermere) are past their 15-25 year expected life span and crowded out light from turf or other plantings. Ivory Silk Lilacs will be planted in their stead, along with a variety of perennials that together will combine for season long color.

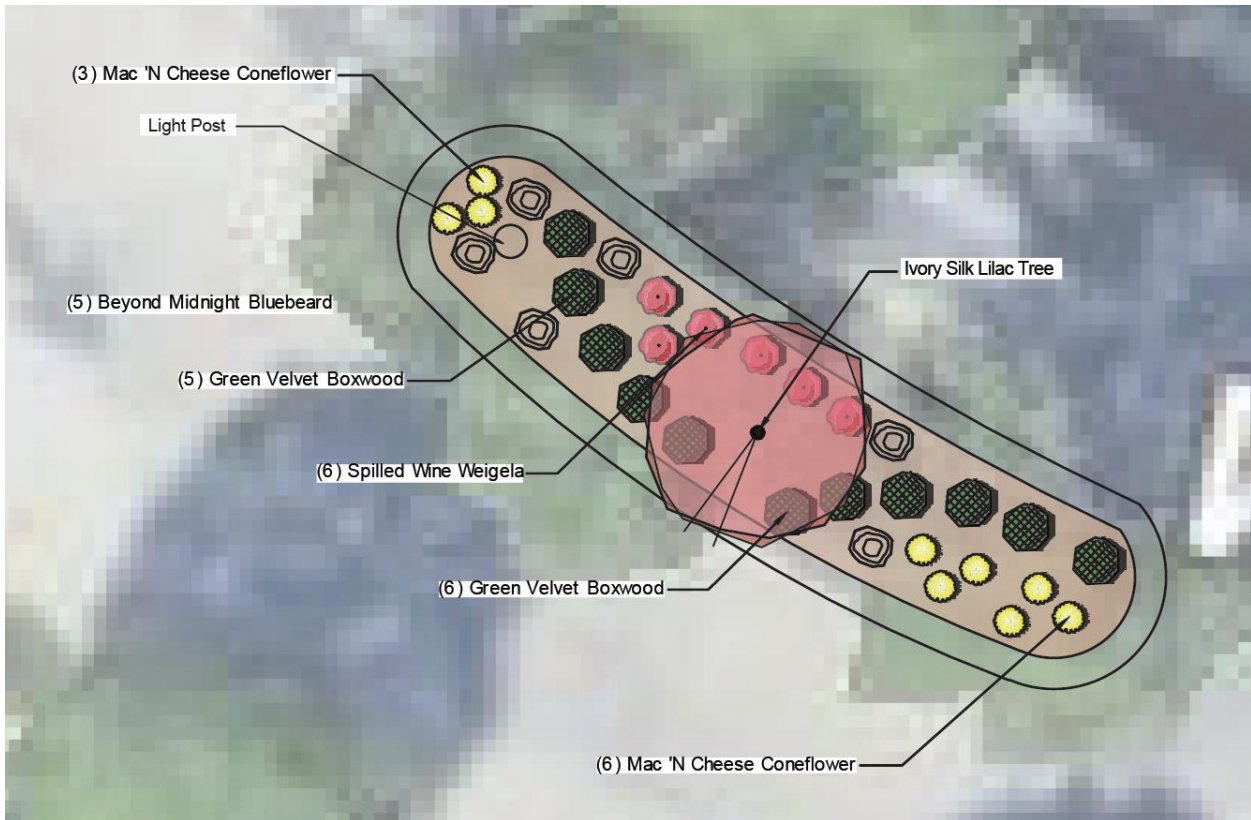
North Island (at entrance from 106th Street):
